




How to add the LPOC to Snapshot


1. Go to patient's "Snapshot" and at the top right you will find a box with a wrench next to it – click on the wrench and you will get a "pop up" box to add in new reports.



2. Type in "Longitudinal Plan of Care" and use the arrows on the left to move the report into the preferred location on the horizontal toolbar – then click Accept.



3. Below is how the toolbar and the LPOC report will show once wrenched in:
