<b>A – Assess</b> - Note if any labs imaging or referrals are going to be made for condition			
<b>T – Treat</b> - Note if any medication changes occurred or continue same			
<b>Only ONE element of MEAT is required per coding guidelines, more is better and preferred but not required</b>
