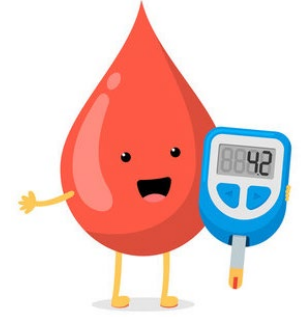
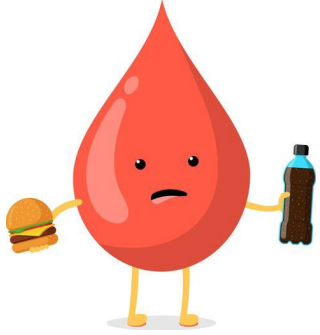


# What is the correct verbiage to document “Uncontrolled” Diabetes?



When ICD-10 was implemented, additional specificity was added to codes requiring providers to specify **Hyperglycemia** or **Hypoglycemia** in their Diabetic patients

Map to 2 different ICD-10s

**Diabetes with Hypoglycemia – E11.641**

**Diabetes with Hyperglycemia – E11.65**



In **2024** new descriptors were added to ICD-10

**Inadequately controlled**

**Out of control**

**Poorly controlled**

All 3 new descriptors map to

**E11.65 - Diabetes with Hyperglycemia**

When documenting for your “uncontrolled” Diabetic patient be sure to either specify

**Hyperglycemia** or **Hypoglycemia**

Or

Utilize the new verbiage for DM with Hyperglycemia
